	Staff Development Day - focused on curriculum - assessment and data use.	
	Yr 3 and Yr 5 - preliminary NAPLAN results have been sent to school. Gives a good view of how students are tracking. Reports sent home will show 4 levels: Needs Support, Developing, Strong or Exceeding. When the student gets Needs Support - school will check to ensure the student is receiving the support they need.	
	Sam O'Kane - needs parent representatives on the homework policy. Matt H and Dominique volunteered.	
	Met with Principals - focused on numeracy for the remainder of the year.	
	School Finance - Significant amount of money has been reduced. \$200k of staffing of supplementary funding has been stopped. Emma St redevelopment : In 2021 - DA approval. 21-23 there wasn't any updates, then a Project Office was allocated Sep/Oct 23. \$330,000 of school and community source money (raised through school funding inc Goodstart and OOSH rent) was allocated to the Emma Street project. Geo technical survey is the next step and will cost \$37k (from the allocated \$330k budget) Schools infrastructure have now advised the project hasn't made the priority list and the money has been frozen. Further discussions to be had.
