Any books ordered after this date will cause a delay in delivery and an additional delivery charge.

Please note that orders are through 2 different suppliers ie Text Books are ordered with Dominie and Exercise Books are ordered through Five Senses.

Stationery lists have also been added to the website, a few have been updated this week since the original posting. Parents please keep your children's special novelty stationery at home. Large pencil cases, rulers that can be tied in knots and rubbers that create a puzzle are not practical and distracting in class.

2019 - Routine Changes

Changes To Routines For 2019

From Term 1 there are a few changes to routines that you need to be aware of.

Start Of School

The school day will be starting 5 minutes earlier each day. This means that the first bell (the go and line up bell) will ring at 8:47am and the start of class bell will ring at 8:50am.

Break Times

Currently, the students have a 20 minute break at recess time and 40 minute break at lunch time. In Term 1, we will be trialling a change to our break times. Recess and lunch will now both be 30 minutes in duration. There will still be a 10 minute eating period for students to eat their lunch and then students will go out to play for 30 minutes.

This initiative has been introduced for a variety of reasons, including allowing more flexibility for training/rehearsal times and as a student wellbeing measure.

Class Formations

Teachers are currently very busy forming classes for next year. Your child will find out which class they are in for 2019, on the first day back for students in Years 1 and 2, and on day 2 for those students attending the swimming carnival.

Students will start the day in their 2018 classes and will be put into their new class during the day. This is a change to the organisation that has been in place for the last few years, where students were placed into their new classes at morning lines.



First Days Back To School – Information For Parents

Wednesday 30th January

Swimming carnival for students in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 plus the Year 2 students who are competing – please refer to the information that has previously been sent to you.

Please note that we will not be forming classes in the morning and respectfully ask that you leave the school playgrounds at 8:50am. Year 1 & 2 classes 2019, will be formed later in the day.

Kindergarten 2019 – Best Start appointments (refer to your letter for date and times).

Year 1, 2019 – if you arrive before 8:47am, play in the playground as normal. When the first bell rings, students are to sit in their 2018 Kindergarten classes, in their usual assembly spot under the K-2 COLA.

Year 2, 2019 – if you arrive before 8:47am, play in the playground as normal. When the first bell rings, students are to sit in their 2018 Year 1 classes, in their usual assembly spot under the K-2 COLA.

Year 2 students who are going to the swimming carnival are to be taken to and from the venue by their parents/carers. Year 3, 2019 – meet your 2018 Year 2 class in the amphitheatre at 8:10am.

Year 4, 5 and 6, 2019 – line up in your 2018 class lines under the 3-6 COLA at 8:10am.

New enrolments who are attending the swimming carnival are to meet in the hall at 8:10am.

End of day arrangements

- Year 1, 2019 students will be brought to the amphitheatre at 2:45pm.
- Year 2, 2019 students will be brought to the K-2 COLA at 2:45pm.
- Year 3-6, 2019 Please arrange a meeting point with your child/children.



2019 First Day Back

Please note that we will not be forming classes in the morning for students in Years 3, 4, 5 & 6 and respectfully ask that parents/carers leave the school playgrounds at 8:50am. Years 3, 4, 5 & 6 classes 2019, will be formed later in the day.

Kindergarten 2019 – Best Start appointments continue. **Year 1, 2019** - play in the K-2 COLA area, as normal. When the bell rings, students line up with their new 2019 class. Students will have been shown where to line up.

Year 2, 2019 - play in the K-2 COLA area, as normal. When the bell rings, students line up with their new 2019 class. Students will have been shown where to line up.

Year 2, 2019 – students who attended the swimming carnival, go to the office.

Year 3, 2019 – if you arrive before 8:47am, play in the K-2 COLA area. When the first bell rings, students are to line up in their Year 2, 2018 class lines under the K-2 COLA.

Year 4, 5, and 6, 2019 – if you arrive before 8:47am, play in the 3-6 COLA area. When the first bell rings students are to line up with their 2018 class, in their assembly spot under the 3-6 COLA.

- Year 2, 2019 meet students under the K-2 COLA, or to meeting point directed by class teacher.


