	the PPSSA (Pittwater Zone PSSA) schools in the area.	
	<ul> <li>Unfortunately as a result of critical shortages of bus drivers, this has</li> </ul>	
	caused havoc with the overall PSSA competition. The 'Northern'	
	Northern beaches are having significant cancellations. 2/9 schools had	
	to cancel PSSA during the summer comp.	
	4/9 can't confirm bus transport for the upcoming winter season.	
	While MVPS still currently have buses confirmed, the concern is that	
	similarly to the swimming carnival, this could change at the last minute	
	and as also the other schools without transport, will pull out of the	
	competition altogether.
