Dear Parents,

Show week is upon us and we are getting ready to fly to Neverland! Below is a lot of important information regarding the upcoming musical. *Please read through it all carefully*.

Highlight it, stick it on the fridge, put notes in your phone- whatever works! This will ensure a smooth running of all shows.

ARRIVAL TIMES

MORNING SHOWS (9.30am-11.30am)

- Your child/ren will need to arrive at school by 8.30am.
- Your child/ren will meet their teacher in their classroom.
- Lead roles/soloists will need to arrive at school by 8am to get dressed in costume (LOCATED IN THE YEAR 4 PAA) and head straight to the Performance Space to be mic fitted..

MATINEE SHOWS (12.30pm-2.30pm)

- Your child/ren will be taken down to the hall by their teacher,
- Lead roles/soloists will be called down to the Performance Space separately to be mic fitted.

EVENING SHOWS (6.00pm - 8.00pm)

- Lead roles/soloists need to be at the Performance Space by 5pm to get mic fitted, arriving fully dressed in their costume.
- Your child/ren will need to be at the hall by 5.30pm, arriving fully dressed in their costume

PICK UP PROCESS

- For the morning and matinee shows, your child will head back to class with their teacher.
- If you wish to take child/ren home early after a matinee show you will need to go to the office first to sign them out, before coming to collect them from the classroom.
- For the evening shows, you must go to your child's teacher and get their name marked off the roll in the hall. THESE SHOWS WILL CONCLUDE AT 7.30PM.
- If someone else is picking up your child/ren please complete the permission slip at the end of this document. YOUR CHILD MUST BRING THIS WITH THEM TO THE PERFORMANCE WHERE THEY ARE BEING COLLECTED BY SOMEONE ELSE.





THEATRE DOOR OPENING TIMES

- Doors to the show will open 20 minutes before the show.
 - o 9.30am Show: Doors open 9.10am
 - 12.30 Show: Doors open 12.10pm
 - o 6.00pm Show: Doors open 5.40pm
 - There is to be no food or drink consumed in the Performance Space.

MERCHANDISE/PROGRAMS/PHOTO WALL

- There will be a photo wall for you to take photos with your child after the show in their costume if you wish. It is at the top of the outdoor area of the Performance Space.
- For Morning and/or Matinee shows, once you have taken photos with your child, please walk them back to their classroom.
- Merchandise will be on sale and is \$5 and will consist of Pirates Gold and/or a Bracelet in a Bottle.
- Pre-Orders for T-Shirts will be up on the Flexischools App. They will cost \$20, with a 2 week turnaround time. Orders are open from 27th July-9th Aug.
- Programs will be provided at each performance.

ADDITIONAL TICKETS

- **NO** tickets will be sold at the door. **ALL** sales must go through the online ticketing link. Plenty of seats are still available to all morning and matinee shows.

HAIR & MAKEUP

- Unless otherwise specified hair needs to be neatly pulled off the face and tied up.
- Makeup should be worn by all students as stage lights can wash out faces. Simple makeup such as blush, lipstick, mascara would be beneficial.
- There are certain roles that need to have additional theatrical makeup. See the descriptions below.
- Please make sure students arrive for each show with hair and makeup done. EVEN if they
 are doing a matinee show, makeup should still be applied.
- There will be teachers in the hall to provide touch ups if need be.
- Additional Makeup:
 - LOST BOYS (YEAR 4)

Dark bronzer smudged on cheeks, forehead etc to make them look 'dirty'.



o PIRATES (YEAR 5/6)

Black scar marks across cheek, beard etc.

COSTUMES

- Below is a reminder of the costumes needed for each role.
 - KINDY/YEAR 1 (NURSERY CHILDREN)
 - Winter pyjamas
 - Covered slippers (nothing that lights up)
 - Stuffed toy.
 - YEAR 2 (NIGHT SKY)
 - Long black pants/tight/leggings/jeans/track pants.
 - Long sleeved black shirt. No logos, colours or writing. Make sure your child's stomach doesn't show when they lift their arms up.
 - Completely black shoes
 - Black socks.
 - YEAR 3 (WILD WARRIORS)
 - Long black pants/tight/leggings/jeans/track pants.
 - Long sleeved black shirt. No logos, colours or writing.
 - Completely black shoes
 - Calf length black socks.
 - Warrior tunics (provided by and kept at school at all times)
 - YEAR 4 (LOST BOYS/GIRLS)
 - Pants & shirt in the following colours: grey, brown, khaki, dark green, camouflage pattern.
 - Old clothes/mixture/ mismatched of above colours
 - Hair needs to look scruffy/messy.
 - MERMAIDS /FAIRIES (YEAR 5/6)
 - All costumes have been provided by the school.
 - The only costume that will be brought home at any point is the mermaid leotard & shorts. At the completion of the final performance these need to be returned to school.
 - If your child is wearing a crop top please ensure it is skin coloured. Hair will be half up/half down.
 - PIRATES (YEAR 5/6)
 - Shirt plain or striped (no brands/prints)
 - Pants can be short of long, old and ripped is great
 - Vest and Belt / scarf / sash around waist
 - Eye patch (as long as it is comfortable to perform in, Bandana, earrings
